



RE: Electric Municipal Aggregation Notification

Dear Village of Oswego Resident,

*This notice is informational only. Your electric utility has informed us that you are **currently served or have chosen to be served by a competitive retail electric supplier**. If you want to continue to receive service from your chosen supplier, you do not need to take any additional action. Consult your contract or contact your chosen supplier for further details if you have questions about your contract, including whether you have a cancellation fee for early termination.*

As you may recall, an electric municipal aggregation program (“Program”) is currently on-going in the Village of Oswego. Because you already receive your electric supply service from a competitive retail electric supplier (or have an application pending to take your electric supply service with a retail electric supplier), you were not included in the opt-out process for the Program. However, you are not precluded from joining the Program. This letter is being sent to you solely for informational purposes so that you may be informed of all your electric supply options.

Dynegy Energy Services was chosen by the Village of Oswego as the retail electric supplier for the aggregation program for July 2016-August 2017. Dynegy Energy Services is an independent seller of power and energy service and is certified as an Alternative Retail Electricity Supplier by the Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC Docket No. 14-0336).

PROGRAM DETAILS

- New price of **\$0.06149 per kWh** is guaranteed until **August 2017**.
- 100% of the energy for this program comes from renewable energy sources.
- There is no enrollment, switching or early termination fee.
- This is a firm, fixed all inclusive rate.

Before enrolling in the Program, you should compare the Village of Oswego aggregation rate to the rate you are currently paying for electric supply to determine if you would benefit from participation in the Program. You should review the terms and conditions associated with your current electric supply, or check directly with your current electric supplier, to determine if there are any penalties or fees associated with an early termination of your current electric supply agreement.
