

RESOLUTION NO. 96-R- 04

WHEREAS, the Village of Oswego is experiencing rapid growth; and

WHEREAS, existing services need to be expanded and new services added to address this growth; and

WHEREAS, one such community service to be expanded is the emergency warning siren system; and

WHEREAS, the cost to install, maintain, and replace such a new system is shown and described on Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, new developments should each bear an equitable share of this expense.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all future developments to be annexed into the Village shall pay a fee to fund such a system upon annexation or plat approval, whichever comes first, according to the following schedule; a separate warning siren fund shall be created to budget for this expenditure; and additional community needs shall be identified and funded in a similar manner should the warning siren fund ever become fully funded.
