Keep your neighborhood green.

Prominently display your address.

Prevent flooding.

Place your trash can at the curb by 6:00 am on your trash day.

Take advantage of free brush pick up.

It's offered free April – October.

Neighborhoods are for residents.

Commercial vehicles exceeding a "B" plate classification may not be stored in a residential area.

Keep you sidewalks safe for your neighbors.

Don't block your sidewalk.

Protect your family.

Replace smoke detector batteries every spring and fall install carbon monoxide detectors.

Inoperable and unlicensed vehicles are unsightly and can be unsafe.

They are prohibited at residences.

Recycle.

It's good for the environment and will save you money. Rinse all containers to reduce contamination.
