“Journey From The Heart”

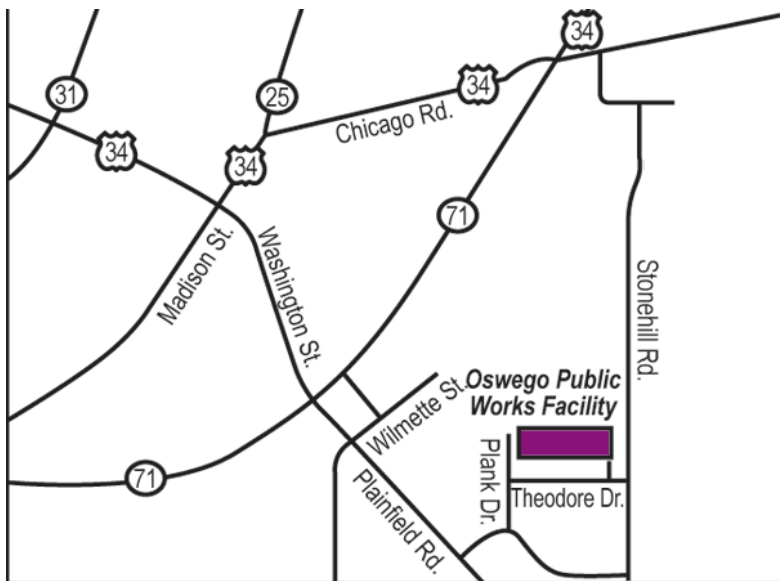
