1. **Invitation to Bids**

Sealed bids will be received until 9:00 a.m., local time, on **September 2, 2011**, at the Department of Public Works, Village of Oswego " Attention: Jerry Weaver", Village of Oswego, 100 Parkers Mill, Oswego, Illinois 60543. All bids must be submitted in sealed envelopes upon the blank form of proposal furnished. Sealed envelopes shall be marked in the upper left hand corner as follows:

After the official bids closing time, the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

2. **Description of the Work**

The work shall consist of all equipment, labor and material necessary to pull and inspect the pump and motor at the Village of Oswego's "Well No. 3". Two bids will be required. One bid will be for the repair of the Byron Jackson pump and motor and one bid will be for the replacement of Byron Jackson pump and motor Well 3 is located at 340 South Madison. Well 3 Specifications are: 200 HP Byron Jackson Submersible Motor, 11 MQL 14 Stage Bowl Assembly, 670' 8" T&C Pipe. Removal of all column piping and transportation to the low bidders yard for inspection by the Director of Public Works. Upon inspection of the pump and motor by the Director of Public Works and the low bidder it will then be determined if the pump and or motor needs to be replaced or can be repaired at the low bidders facility. Also required with bids will be a letter from Byron Jackson certifying that the low bidder is certified to repair or provide Byron Jackson pumps.

3. **Awarding Authority**

The awarding authority for this contract is the Village Board for the Village of Oswego who reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any or all bids.

4. **Site Conditions**

Each prospective Bidder shall inspect in detail the Work Site and the surrounding area and shall familiarize itself with all local conditions, including subsurface, underground and other concealed conditions. The Bidder whose Bids is accepted will be responsible for all errors in its Bids including those resulting from its failure or neglect to make a thorough examination and investigation of the conditions of the Work Site and the surrounding area.

5. **Bid Opening**

Owner will receive sealed Bids for the Work until 9:00 a.m., local time, on September 2, 2011, at Owner's office listed above, at which time, or as soon thereafter as possible, all Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

6. **Bid Security, Bonds and Insurance**

Performance and Payment Bonds. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Labor and Material Payment Bond upon award of the Contract. Each Bid must be accompanied by a letter from such a surety company stating that it will execute Bonds in the form included in the Contract Documents upon award of the Contract to Bidder.
